Notice inviting expression of interest for appointment of a Programme Consultant in West Bengal Commission for Protection of Child Rights.

West Bengal Commission for Protection of Child Rights is a Statutory Body constituted in exercise of the power conferred under section 17(1) of Commissions for Protection of Child Rights Act, 2005.

The mandate of the Commission is to examine safeguards for children and inquire into complaints of violation of child rights by State or private individuals or entities. It also entails inspection of custodial institutions for children, examining factors that affect the enjoyment of rights by children and recommending remedial measures. In doing so the Commission is guided by the obligations under Right to Education Act, 2009, POCSO Act, 2012, Juvenile Justice Care Act, 2000 and CPCR Act, 2005.

With a view to discharging Commission's obligations effectively Commission, in observance of rule 24 of WBCPCR Rules, 2012, proposes to engage a Programme Consultant for a period of one year. Such a consultant will be required to assist the Commission for discharging duties in connection with organization of different types of programmes such as seminars, workshops throughout the year in all over West Bengal.

The Consultant may also be deputed by the Commission to different Task Forces or Committees and also for research and analysis of issues relating to protection of Child Rights.

Such consultant should have experience in academic/ administrative/ investigative/legal/Civil Society activities etc.

For the above purpose Commission will prepare a panel of Consultants from amongst the applicants which will remain valid for a period of one year. As regards honorarium /fees of such Consultants the same will be negotiable. The applicants, however, are requested to indicate their expectation of honorarium/fee in their applications for empanelment. Persons willing to be empanelled as Consultant may please convey their expression of interests to the Chairperson of West Bengal Commission for Protection for Child Rights giving their C.V.s and work experience in detail which should reach this Commission's office latest by 30/09/2019. The Commission, however, reserves the right to empanel persons other than the applicants as consultants.
